4. Mounted exhibits will be on firm backing, no larger than 11x14 and able to be hung.
5. Reproductions will be disqualified.

1. Advertising items, any media (3), must be at least 20 years old.
2. Household items (3), must be at least 20 years old.
3. Tools, instruments, small equipment (3), must be at least 20 years old.
4. Buttons, garment, mounted, 20 or more (1 mounting), must be at least 20 years old.
5. Buttons, campaign, mounted, 5 or more (1 mounting), must be at least 10 years old.

6. Thimbles mounted or in container, 10 or more; must be at least 20 years old.
7. Items from nature, of one category (leaves, shells, insects, etc) 10 items
8. Printed material, named, mounted, 10 items
9. Sports memorabilia, named, mounted
10. Any other collection

## **CLASS Y – SCRAPBOOKING**

Each scrapbook shall be entered in a 3-ring binder or other bound fashion.  
Entries must include at least 5 pages of materials scrapbooked in the last year.
